




Bond Proposition

- **High School Projects**
 - Multipurpose educational/activity center
 - CTE classrooms; indoor practice area for physical education, band, cheer, dance, and all sports; dressing rooms; weight room, and training room

- **District-wide Projects**

 - Four (4) buses



Student Experience Projects

- The bond will provide safety and security measures across the District to meet TEA standards.
- The proposed expansion of the middle school campus will facilitate moving sixth grade students out of the elementary school.
- The Career & Technology Education (CTE) classroom space at the Multipurpose Education & Activity Center eliminates high school students travel to the Norma Webb Center.
- The 18 Plus Program and the LEP Academy will move to the 1923 building.
- The elementary wing will be renovated to create a district daycare.

Total Proposal: \$90 Million

Estimated Tax Impact To Homeowner

This chart estimates the maximum projected monthly tax impact on the appraised market value of a homestead only, including the state mandated homestead exemption of \$140,000.

Appraised Home Market Value	State Mandated Homestead Exemption	Taxable Home Value After \$140,000 exemption	Projected I&S Tax Rate Increase	Projected Monthly Increase
\$250,000	-\$140,000	\$110,000	\$0.3662	\$33.57
\$300,000	-\$140,000	\$160,000	\$0.3662	\$48.83
\$350,000	-\$140,000	\$210,000	\$0.3662	\$64.09
\$400,000	-\$140,000	\$260,000	\$0.3662	\$79.34
\$450,000	-\$140,000	\$310,000	\$0.3662	\$94.60

This tax rate increase will not impact senior citizens on their homesteads who have a 65 or over exemption on file with the tax office. (Significant improvements to a homestead can increase the taxes.)
